

All ballots must be **postmarked by April 22**, **received by April 25** and include your **NMRA** # for verification. Vote for <u>One</u> candidate for Superintendent, <u>One</u> candidate for Assistant Superintendent and no more than **Two** candidates for the Board of Directors.

Note: NMRA does not allow FAMILY MEMBERS to vote, nor does the Midwest Region.

Article IV, Membership and Dues, of the NMRA Regulations includes the following provision in Section 2: "B. Each member in the above classes, including Honorary Life Member, shall have the right to:"

"4. Except for Family Members; and Sustaining and Corporate Members other than individuals, the right to vote and run for an elective office in any Region or Division of which the member is a resident member, subject to any qualifications and conditions
